Date	Sunday 23 Oct 2005 - All events are timed finals. Meet start at 10:00.
Warm-up	09:00 - NATO Marlins & Brussels Octopus 09:30 – Sigonella Swordfish & SHAPE Seals
Security	All persons entering the NATO Staff Center Sports Complex must hold a NATO or SHAPE members or family pass, or have been previously identified to the NATO Office of Security (NOS) and placed on a list with the gate guards . This list must be provided to the NMS president or meet coordinator at least one week prior to the event . All participating swimmers or visitors watching the event must be pre-registered.
Food & Drink	Concessions will be available and located in a room adjacent to the restaurant (must actually walk through the restaurant) which is co-located in the pool complex. Food and drinks may be purchased, as desired. Euros accepted. Everyone must wear footwear and wear a T-shirt or other garment to cover their bathing suit. Please be respectful when walking through restaurant area.
Pool	25m indoor-heated pool with 6 lanes, fresh water, non-turbulent, single lane lines, deep & shallow ends, competition start blocks in deep end. Overhead starts will be used, NO street shoes allowed in the pool are, bathing caps are mandatory , limited shower facilities. No food & ONLY plastic bottles allow in the pool area. No flash pictures while the swimmers are on the starting blocks at the beginning of a heat.
Eligibility:	Open to all registered members of EFSL swim teams, iaw EFSL eligibility.
Entry Limit:	Swimmers are limited to a maximum of 3 individual events and 2 relays, number of swimmers unlimited.
Entries:	Please e-mail your entries electronically to the NMS statistician iaw EFSL standard time schedules . Final scratches submitted at lifeguard office on hour prior to start of meet. IAW EFSL rules no additions will be made on day of meet. Please bring a back up of entries.
Hosting:	Hosting is offered for visiting swimmers, in the homes of our NMS families. For more information, please contact the NMS meet coordinator
