Security	All person age 12 years old or older entering the NATO Staff Center Sports Complex must hold a NATO or SHAPE members or family pass, or have been previously identified to the NATO Office of Security (NOS) and placed on a list. This list must be passed to the security office at least one week prior to the event. Therefore all swimmers who are participating in or visitors watching the event must be pre-registered.
Food & Drink	Concessions will be provided in the room located on the second floor of the facility. Everyone must wear footwear and wear a T-shirt or other garment to cover their bathing suit. There is a restaurant co-located with the pool. Food and drinks may be purchased, as desired. Euros accepted.
Pool	25m indoor-heated pool with 6 lanes, fresh water, non-turbulent, single lane lines, deep & shallow ends competition start blocks in deep end.
Eligibility:	Open to all registered members of EFSL swim teams and IAW EFSL Swim code eligibility criteria.
Entry Limit:	Number of swimmers unlimited; swimmers are limited to a maximum of 3 individual events and 2 relays
Entries:	Please e-mail your entries electronically to our statistician Shaji Kumar at shaji.mini@skynet.be by in accordance with EFSL standard time schedules. Final scratches submitted at lifeguard office by 09:00 on the day of the meet. IAW EFSL rules no additions will be made on day of meet. Please bring a back up disc of entries.

Other Info:	We will employ overhead starts, which require the swimmer to remain in the water until the swimmer from the next event has left the starting block. ALL swimmers must wear bathing caps.
