<p>Coming from Mons through Liège/Luik/Lüttich and Maastricht</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • E42 to E40 to E25 to E314/A76 then follow towards Heerlen; • Continue until exit for N281 towards Heerlen-Noord. You will see signs that say “Woonboulevard”. Take the exit after the gas station on the right. At the bottom you turn right. You continue this road through traffic lights, under the railway, another set of traffic lights until you hit the traffic circle. Take a left at the circle and follow towards “Brunssum”. The name of the street is “Terhoevenderweg”; • Continue through a traffic light .8 miles (1.3 km) to a traffic circle. Continue straight thru. Go another .6 miles (1 km) to another traffic circle and again go straight thru. The name of the street changes to “Aker straat Noord”. Continue another .1 mile (.2 km) to large traffic circle. You will see a bus station at this traffic circle. Go right at this traffic circle onto ‘Emma Weg’; • Go 1.4 miles (2.3 km) straight thru 3 traffic circles. Continue 0.5 miles (0.8 km) on same road going down a hill. The name of the road has now changed to K. Doormanstraat. You will see a sign to JFC Brunssum just before you hit the traffic lights. Continue straight thru this traffic light and the following set of lights (passing the police station on your right). At the following traffic circle you turn right onto the base. The swimming pool is to the left at the first traffic circle on base. The pool is at the bottom of the hill.
<p>Coming from Brussels</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • E314/A2 onto E233/A76 across the border with NL; follow towards Aken/Aachen • After “Kerensheide” it will be 9 km until exit “Ten Esschen”. Follow exit onto N281 and take first exit (Woonboulevard). At the bottom of the exit at traffic lights turn left • You continue this road through traffic lights, under the railway, another set of traffic lights until you hit the traffic circle. Take a left at the circle and follow towards “Brunssum”. The name of the street is “Terhoevenderweg”; • Continue through a traffic light .8 miles (1.3 km) to a traffic circle. Continue straight thru. Go another .6 miles (1 km) to another traffic circle and again go straight thru. The name of the street changes to “Aker straat Noord”. Continue another .1 mile (.2 km) to large traffic circle. You will see a bus station at this traffic circle. Go right at this traffic circle onto ‘Emma Weg’; • Go 1.4 miles (2.3 km) straight thru 3 traffic circles. <p>Coming from Aachen</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow sign to Antwerpen/Eindhoven/Heerlen. The A4 will turn into E314/A76 when you cross the Dutch border; • Continue on the E314/A76 until Exit 6, Voerendaal/Heerlen-Noord. At top of exit turn right and continue through traffic lights under the overpass. This road is named Beersdalweg; • You continue this road through traffic lights, under the railway, another set of traffic lights until you hit the traffic circle. Take a left at the circle and follow towards “Brunssum”. The name of the street is “Terhoevenderweg”; • Continue through a traffic light .8 miles (1.3 km) to a traffic circle. Continue straight thru. Go another .6 miles (1 km) to another traffic circle and again go straight thru. The name of the street changes to “Aker straat Noord”. Continue another .1 mile (.2 km) to large traffic circle. You will see a bus station at this traffic circle. Go right at this traffic circle onto ‘Emma Weg’; • Go 1.4 miles (2.3 km) straight thru 3 traffic circles. Continue 0.5 miles (0.8 km) on same road going down a hill. The name of the road has now changed to K. Doormanstraat. You will see a sign to JFC Brunssum just before you hit the traffic lights. We suggest a team roster with both swimmers and parents name (whether they plan to attend or not). If those attending are military ID card holders, access should not be a problem other than being a little more time consuming. If, however, persons attending are civilian or do not possess an ID, it is imperative that we pass their names (passport number and date of birth are required) to the security police at JFC HQ Brunssum. The list must be forwarded to us at least 5 working days in advance.
