Directions: From Valkenberg	<p>Take E314/A76 towards Heerlen. Continue until Exit for N281 (Heerlen-Nord). You will see signs that say Woenboulevard. Take this exit off the right and stay to the right. You will exit again off the first right. At the bottom, turn left under underpass onto road named Beersdalweg.</p> <p>About .4 miles (.6 km) you will pass a MacDonald on the right. Continue on another .2 miles (.3 km) to a large traffic circle (Volvo dealership off the right).</p> <p>Take the third exit off the traffic circle towards Brunssum. The name of the street is Terhoevenderweg.</p> <p>Continue through a traffic light .8 miles (1.3 km) to a traffic circle. Continue straight thru. Go another .6 miles (1 km) to another traffic circle and again go straight thru. The name of the street changes to Aken Str Noord. Continue another .1 mile (.2 km) to large traffic circle. You will see the famous Capricorn (druggie bar) on the left. Take first right off traffic circle onto Emma Weg.</p> <p>Go 1.4 miles (2.3km) straight thru 3 traffic circles. Continue .5 miles (.8 km) on same road, which has by now changed name to K Doormanstraat. You will see a sign to RHQ AFNORTH just before the traffic light. Continue straight thru this traffic light. At .4 miles (.6 km) you will go straight thru another traffic light. At .3 miles (.5km) beyond that, you will arrive to a traffic circle. Turn right to enter the new RHQ AFNORTH main gate.</p> <p>You are almost there. After the gate, at the small traffic circle, you turn left to enter the H600 area (road or parking area on your left hand). The pool is at the bottom of the hill. Note that this area is under reconstruction, and parking can be difficult. Instructions for parking will be given to the team P.O.C. before the meet, or by an ORCAS representative waiting at the gate.</p>
From GK	<p>At Teveren take a left toward Herleen. Across the boarder at Ubaak Over Worm follow direction Brunssum. As you enter Brunssum, take a left (at the round about with Yellow Swords in center), to enter the JFC HQ Brunssum. The pool is on the left side.</p>

Pool Course:	Indoor, heated, 25m, 5 lanes, fresh water, non-turbulent, competition single lane lines, deep & shallow ends with competition starting blocks in the deep end.
Eligibility:	Open to all registered members of the Orcas International Swim Team, and invited teams' members.
