10) **105.2 Score Sheets (TM2-page6)**

- ◆ Problem: Meet results takes too long to be sent to the EFSL Stats
- ◆ Martin Proposal: Change and re-enforce the Bylaws
  - The host team is responsible for sending the results of all regular meets to the EFSL statistician within 5 working days (by 2000 hrs on Tuesday night following the meet). A \$25 (\$50) fine will be levied against the team whose results are not received by the deadline (time stamped) and another \$25 (\$50) for each 10 (5) working days thereafter.
  - The results of the last competition of the season must be sent within 3 working days (2 calendar days) after the meet to the statistician for the results to be implemented in the overall statistics for the seeding meeting (or a \$100 fine will be levied against the team). (Proposal – teams must submit divisional meet results to EFSL Statistician within 24 hours after the end of the meet.)
- ◆ Discussion:

- The original \$25 fine is 30 years old. Since every team is using electronic mail, there is no reason to wait 1 week.
- Since the time between Divisionals and the Seeding meeting was reduced to 1 week the 2<sup>nd</sup> change is necessary.
- ◆ Proposal to the Presidents: The above Technical meeting proposal is a Bylaws proposal change. The text in black is the original statement and the proposal changes are in red, and reflect mainly the following:
  - Host team MUST submit competition results by 2000hrs on the Tuesday following the meet.
  - A \$50 fine will be levied against the team whose results are not received by the deadline (time stamped) and another \$50 for each 5 working days thereafter.
  - The results of the last competition of the season (Divisionals) MUST be submitted to EFSL Head Stat within 24 hours (otherwise a \$100 fine will be levied against the offending Team).

11) Regular meet Shell & Extended optional events(TM1-page 5):

- ◆ Problems:
  - Regular meets are getting too long!
  - Some teams who rent pool are having problem to finish meets without extension of hours, which could get costly.
- ◆ It all comes down to the hosting team to take action to follow the meet plan, and not over book the meet!
- ◆ Proposal:
  - Create a standardize Meet Announcement Form
    - Post the template on the Website
    - Teams' Meet Director
      - To use it as a minimum to follow the standard
      - Post the completed Meet Announcement form on their website so all the hosted teams have access to it
    - All PoC MUST be on Meet Announcement
- ◆ Therefore, Extended meet shell will be offered (like last year) as follow:
  - The program will offer events to the 13 and older age group on a rolling basis from September to end December
    - September/October: 50 fly & 200 back
    - October/ November: 50 back & 200 breast
    - November/December: 50 breast & 200 fly
    - December/January: 200 fly & 50 breast
  - Note: The exact offered strokes time frame will be posted on the Website after the league schedule is finalized.

12) Regular meet events qualifying/seeding time (TM3-page 7)

- ◆ Problem: Not all the meets require a seeding time for defined strokes
- ◆ Proposal:
  - No required seed times for the regular season.
  - Long distance events in the extended meet shell – boys and girls heats, can be combined for time constraints, with no requirement to have a lane to separate them.

13) **Aging up, date**(TM3-page 9):

- ◆ Problem: It seems we are favoring a few swimmers by allowing them to swim at Champs after turning a year older after Jan 1<sup>st</sup>
- ◆ **Proposal:**
  - **Option 1:** Change to swimmers swimming the age group for the age they are on August 1. (Example: swimmer is 11 on August 1 but has an August 13 birthday. Swimmer swims the entire season as an 11 year old.)
  - **Option 2:** Have age up date be December 1
    - ◇ This would be right after the LDM, thus
      - Advantaging some swimmers for the LDM Champs
      - Advantaging some swimmers for the EFSL Individual Champs (EOY)
  - Use the USS Swimming Rule Book if necessary, and leave it the way it is now!

15) **Divisionals (BOD-page 5):**

- ◆ Teams in divisions are keeping track of whose turn it is to host, and take arrangement between themselves in accordance of the possibility of a particular year
  - Division Teams to define who will be hosting Divisionals

- ◆ To help teams organizing logistics, the board agreed to set a dead line date for the host team to submit the final date the meet will be conducted

16) **Sanctions for teams that DON'T meet deadlines (BOD-page 9).**

- ◆ It has been noted throughout the last few years that teams are not meeting deadlines set by the EFSL causing different problems in some areas!
- ◆ Problem areas:
  - Participation in Clinics
  - Submission of Rosters
  - Submission of Meet Results
  - Bringing minimum number of workers to meets
  - Non Payment of Fees
- ◆ Proposal:
  - Sanctions should be levied in reference of the following
    - ◇ Teams will not be able to host sanctioned meets if they did not attend the Clinics.
    - ◇ Team results will not be authenticated for League Standings if the roster deadline is not met.
    - ◇ Team results will not be authenticated for League Standings if the roster deadline is not met.
    - ◇ Visiting Teams must notify the hosting team if they are unable to bring the required number of meet workers per EFSL Bylaw: 104.2
    - ◇ EFSL Proposes as a minimum:
      - o 1-10 Seeded swimmers – 1 volunteer
      - o 11-25 Seeded swimmers = 3volunteers
      - o 26-40 Seeded swimmers = 5 volunteers
      - o 41+ Seeded swimmers = 7 volunteers

17) **Long Distance Meet (BOD-Page 9 & TM2-page 8)**

- ◆ Problems:
  - Decide what is real about the long distance meet. Are they Champs events or not? Yes
- ◆ Proposal:
  - Make the LDM a meet on its owned
  - Change name to EFSL Long Distance Championships (independent of the EFSL Individual Champs, held at the End of the Year, EOY).
  - A northern and southern meet conducted the same day.
  - EFSL to award a long distance medal – separate of the EOY Champs medal.
    - ◇ Results will be compiled
    - ◇ Awards will be mailed to the teams for presentation to their swimmers.

- Charge splash fees to cover expenses of running the meet (if necessary) and awards.
- Allow swimmers to swim up to 3 events (11 & older).
  - ◇ Events offered per USA Swimming Code: All ages;
    - 400IM, 800 Free, 1500 Free.
    - 10 & U can only swim 800 Free as a separate event
- Retain minimum seedtime.
- Start keeping records, we have:

**18) Individual Championship (EOY), (BOD-page1 & 8):**

- ◆ 201.3 Meet Order of Events
  - ◆ **Martin proposed** to put a 3<sup>rd</sup> event to the Saturday schedule to make the relays possible on Sunday.
  - ◆ Saturday session will start at 1200 hrs (after the warm-up starting at 1000 hrs):
    - 12 & under: 100 IM, 50 back and 50 free
    - 13 -19: 100 back, 400 free and 50 free
    - Saturday session will take place in the Training Pool under the spectator stands.
    - Swimmers will be allowed to swim 3 events on Saturday.
    - The Board will request that the bulkhead will be removed for the 50M Events.
      - Confirmed by the Pool manager
  - ◆ **Note:** Martin have chosen 50 Free due to the fact that this stroke is the fastest event, discussion on the stroke will be necessary.
  - ◆ The Board agreed to move the 50 Free events to the Saturday session. This event has the highest number of heats but it is the fastest stroke. This will help keep the Sunday schedule on time.
  - ◆ Sunday session will start at 0930 hrs:
    - Parade will mark the beginning of the Sunday Session
      - ◇ Medley Relay
      - ◇ All ages: 200 free
      - ◇ 12 & under: 50 fly
      - ◇ 13-19: 100 fly
      - ◇ 12 & under: 50 breast
      - ◇ 13-19: 100 breast
      - ◇ All ages: 100 free
      - ◇ Freestyle relay
    - 3 events allowed per swimmer.
  - ◆ Swimmers will be able to swim 3 individual events on Saturday, and 3 individual events plus two relays events on Sunday.
  - ◆ Only "A" relays will be seeded.
  - ◆ Awards
    - 1-6 medals, 7-16 ribbons
    - No relay medals
  - ◆ Minimum one heat guaranty at Champs
    - If there are no qualifiers in an event, the event will be seeded for one heat.
  - ◆ The board think that this would be the next step towards real 2 days Champs, and leaves room to add the 200 m events in all of the remaining strokes.

19) **BYLAWS-Proposed Changes (in red)**

◆ **103.2 Establishing League Records** (TM-page 12)

1) League records are established by swimming faster times than the existing times listed with the league statistician at EFSL sanctioned meets and the EFSL championship meets at the end of the season.

*League Records are to be announced to the League Statistician through the **hosting team Head Statistician.***

*Ref.: US Swimming rules and regulations 102.21*

*This reinforces an existing rule from the Statistician's training.*

- (2) New league records must be officially listed with the league statistician before the spring league meeting at the conclusion of the swim-season. At the conclusion of the spring meeting all league records will be considered official and no further changes can be made. **Unless there is legitimate proof provided by the discovering team provided to the EFSL Statistician.**
- (3) An individual swimmer, or a relay team consisting of swimmers of the same age group, **or the lead swimmer of a relay** may establish league records regardless of the age group in which he/she/they compete(s). The record will apply to the actual age group of the swimmer.
- (4) Relays consisting of swimmers out of their age group may establish League records. **Relay records can only be established if all swimmers are in the proper age bracket.**
- (5) Relays consisting of swimmers of mixed age groups may not establish league records. **(Delete this sentence.)**

(6) League record breakers, individual and relays, will receive at the end of the season, latest at the spring league meeting, an award for each stroke they broke a record in.

◆ **107.12 Seeding Procedures** (BOD-page 6)

- Change in this article will mainly reflect this year Champs new events distribution, and one paragraph will be added to clarify the seeding procedure

- (1) There will be no electronic pre-seeding for CHAMPS. The meet will be seeded at a "seeding meeting" to be held no later than 2 weeks prior to CHAMPS. A representative from each team must attend this meeting.
- (2) Once an event has been seeded, and all teams agree, that event is closed and there will no changes made. Team representatives must be prepared for this meeting to include knowledge of which events a swimmer desires to swim and the representative must keep track of how many events a swimmer is seeded for during the course of the meeting.
- (3) **At the "Seeding Meeting" swimmers may only be seeded in 3 events on Saturday and 3 Events on Sunday, this includes pick-up and alternate. If a swimmer is seeded in more than 3 events on Sunday, they will be scratched from the first seeded Sunday event. For complete clarification this means if a swimmer is placed in a non-**

qualified event as a swim up and then placed in qualified events over the limit they will be scratched from the first seeded (qualified) event. All coaches and statisticians must understand this prior to the seeding meeting.

Example: John Smith is seeded in:

200IM (as a qualified time)

50M Fly (as a pick up)

200 Free (as a qualified time)

50 Breast (as an alternate),

- ◇ (3) A minimum of 14 days notice is required prior to the convening of a meeting of the Governing Body, and publication of the Agenda Items".
